WHAT IS THIS WORKSHOP?

Painted ceramics is a Surface design an artwork (pattern, illustration, hand lettering, etc.) made by a designer/artist intended to be applied to a surface by hand painting to enhance its visual appearance and functionality.

The underglaze technique paints a surface of metallic oxides and ceramic stains on bisque ware. Metallic oxides such as copper, cobalt, iron, manganese, rutile, nickel, etc., and the manufactured palette of ceramic stain colors made from these oxides called underglazes, can be mixed to watercolour consistency and painted on bisque ware, then covered immediately with a layer of transparent glaze.

A layer of glaze will make a surface imperviable to liquids. sparkling shine will be on the surface painted illustration/ written notes will be clearly visible through glazed surface, under glazed ceramic is completely safe for daily use.
