This workshop is open to anyone who is interested in working with hands and have fun with colorful textiles



VISHNUPRIYA NARAYANAN **ANCHOR FACULTY**

Vishnupriya Narayanan trained in Textile Design at the National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad. She began her career working with block printers in Jaipur for a home décor collection at Maison & Objet 2011. As part of an IGNCA-NID project, she studied textiles, looms, and craft practices of over 50 tribes across Assam, Manipur, Tripura, and Arunachal Pradesh.

She has taught design process and thinking at NID, IIT Gandhinagar, and SEAS, Ahmedabad University. Her interest in sustainable craft grew through a 2008 World Economic Forum initiative. She has documented the Khadi tradition of Ponduru and block-printing in Gujarat.

Vishnupriya values hands-on learning demonstrated this through a project converting paper waste into tiles. She continues to explore design as a practitioner, researcher, and educator.
