What is this Workshop about?

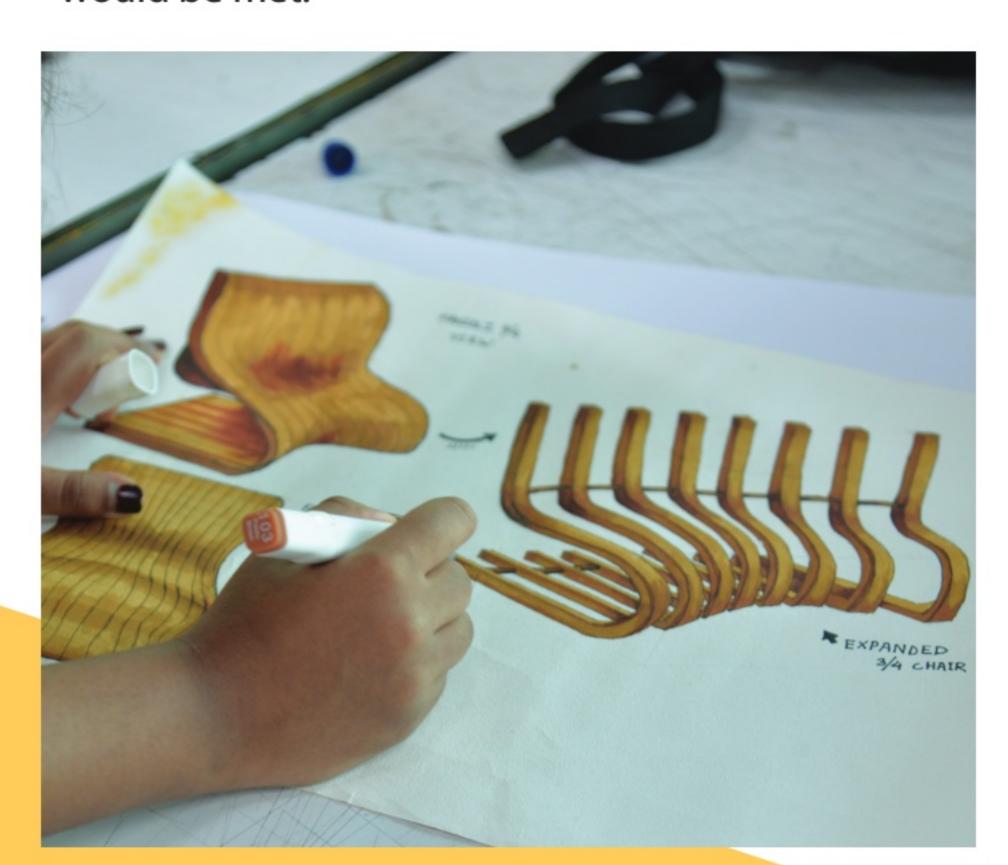
This workshop attempts to build an understanding of Product Design, for interested individuals who are passionate about innovation and creativity.
