What is this Workshop about?

Bamboo is among the most sustainable and renewable natural resources, traditionally used for everything from lifestyle products to infrastructure. India is home to five species of solid bamboo—dense varieties from the grass family—widely cultivated for commercial use, especially in furniture making. The NID Centre for Bamboo Initiatives has been actively exploring the potential of these species in design and product development. This hands-on workshop introduces participants to solid bamboo, its unique properties, tools, and techniques for creating furniture and interior products. With a focus on "connect, construct, and create," participants will ideate and build their own pieces under the guidance of skilled master trainers. The workshop also covers bamboo processing, finishing methods, and craftsmanship, offering an immersive experience into sustainable material design.

- 3. Learning joinery systems of solid bamboo
- 4. Ideation of new products / furniture

Dr. Susanth C. S. is a seasoned designer and educator with over 25 years of experience in furniture design and bamboo applications. A graduate of NID Ahmedabad (1998), he began his career with NID's Consultancy Services and later served as faculty at the Ahmedabad and Bengaluru campuses. In 2007, he established the Design for Retail Experience master's program at NID Bengaluru. Dr. Susanth has worked extensively on furniture, interiors, and bamboo-based projects, collaborating with craft clusters across India. A key focus of his work has been the promotion and innovation of bamboo through design, workshops, exhibitions, and research. Since 2010, he has headed NID's Centre for Bamboo Initiatives. In 2024, he completed his PhD on the evaluation and standardization of joinery systems in solid bamboo furniture. Over the years, he has held multiple administrative roles and represented NID at various national and international seminars and conferences.
